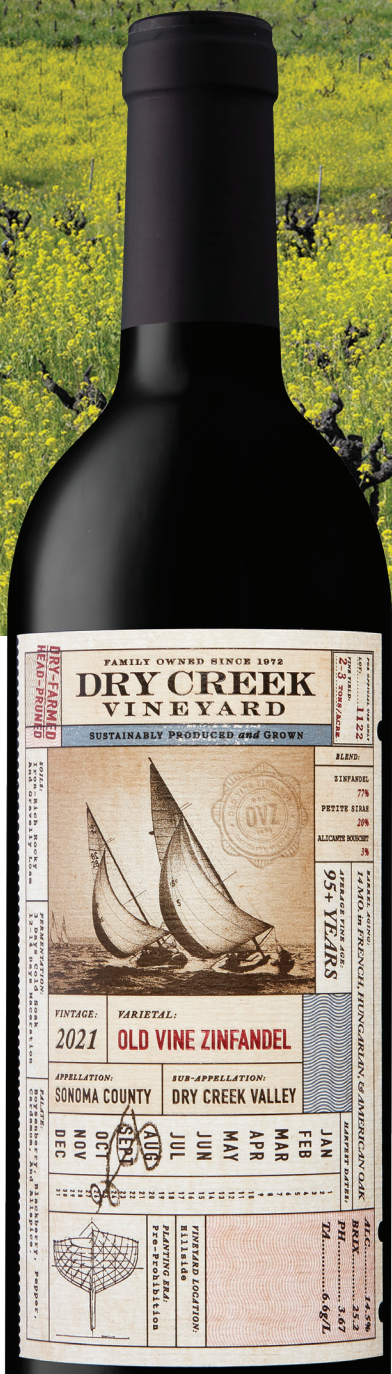

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- Dry Creek Vineyard was the first to coin the term “Old Vine” in 1987 for wines made from pre-Prohibition vines.
- Produced from historic, dry-farmed vines averaging more than 95+ years in age, resulting in more intense flavors.
- Packaging honors the iconic nature of the old vines and details winemaking and geography.
- Patented cork closure is laser-printed with data such as the age of the cork forest, harvest date of the trees and sustainable habitat information.
